The cat's out the hat its time to borrow more money again and this time its another Billion, sigh for the love of our country will we ever pay off this debt? The answer to that maybe no, but we are still holding on firm.

Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance K Peter Turnquest yesterday tabled notice of a resolution that will authorize him to raise \$1.34 billion to defray expenditure.

According to the resolution, the sum can be raised through the creation and issuance

of registered stock, loan agreements with banks, and the issuance and sale of bonds. Turnquest said total revenues are expected to decline to roughly \$2.1 billion, and expenditures estimated to rise to some \$2.8 billion at the end of FY2019/20.

"I would note here that the Government is intent on focusing its debt management strategy over the medium term, to effect the best benefit to the citizens of The Bahamas," Turnquest said.

"In this light, we are in the process of a debt conversion for a number of loan facilities that will

allow us to lock-in fixed rates in a low interest rate environment. This should result in debt servicing savings even in the near term.

He continued: "Though it will not be easy, we can glean on the lessons from a number of our regional counterparts that it is better to address these issues sooner, rather than later. To restore the fiscal affairs of our country, this Administration will remain disciplined in its fiscal management over the medium to long term."

The Bahamas never manufactured any drug, we simply had foreigners use our waters and airspace to travel drugs from south America into North America. But without further ado here is the origin of crack.

While the use of cocaine leaves as an intoxicant

dates back three thousand years, crack cocaine, a crystallized form of cocaine, was developed during the cocaine boom of the 1970s and its use spread in the mid-1980s.

According to the US Drug Enforcement Agency, by the late 1970s there was a huge glut of cocaine powder being shipped into the United States. This caused the price of the drug to drop by as much as 80%. Faced with dropping prices for their illegal product, drug dealers converted the powder to "crack," a solid form of cocaine that could be smoked.

Broken into small chunks, or "rocks," this form of cocaine could be sold in smaller quantities, to more people at bigger profit. It was cheap, simple to produce, easy to use, and highly profitable for dealers. As early as 1980, reports of crack use were appearing in Los Angeles, San Diego & Houston. The biggest surge in the use of the drug occurred during the "crack epidemic," between 1984 and 1990, when the drug spread across American cities. The crack epidemic dramatically increased the number of Americans addicted to co-

caine. In 1985, the number of people who admitted using cocaine on a routine basis increased from 4.2 million to 5.8 million.

By the end of 1986, crack was available in twenty-eight states and the District of Colum-

bia. By 1987, crack was reported to be available in all but four states in the United States. Since then, use of the drug has continued to spread throughout North and South America and into Europe and the rest of the world. By 2002, the United Kingdom was experi-

encing their own "crack epidemic," with the number of crack addicts seeking help climbing nearly 50% that year. The UK reported an increase of 74% in seizures of crack cocaine in drug raids between 2000 and 2006.



NO TO EXTENDING LOCKDOWN

NO to extending lockdown. With the government expected to bring to Parliament yesterday a resolution to extend the state of public emergency put in place in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Progressive Liberal Party (PLP) Leader Philip Brave Davis yesterday called on the Minnis administration to end lockdowns, and gave early notice that the official opposition will not support an extension.

The state of emergency allowed the prime minister as the competent authority to impose a 24-hour curfew and weekend

lockdowns to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. "I don't know if we can support any more of these lockdowns," Davis said.

He added, "It and of itself is not the answer. That has to be accommodated by many other things and we don't seem to have those other things to make a lockdown effective."

"I think the Bahamian people are responsible enough that once they understand it, they will do it. So, you don't have to force them."

Asked if he was calling for the end of the restrictions, Davis replied, "Yes."

Governor General C.A. Smith declared a state of public emergency

in The Bahamas on March 18. It has been extended twice already. It is currently set to expire at the end of this month.

Asked yesterday whether the prime minister had indicated plans to extend the restrictions, Davis replied, "Last time y'all asked him about me, he said he don't listen to Brave Davis..."

"You would expect that we would be in contact with each other at least to talk ourselves through this, but he's the competent authority, and so he doesn't need any advice because he is the competent authority."

Davis said lockdowns and curfews are "not sufficient".



"If you're locking down, it has to be accompanied by other things like tracing, isolation," the opposition leader said. "We don't know what they're doing. What is the rate of their testing? We have less than 300,000 persons on this island. Why have we not tested them all by now? Or at least a significant amount of them?"



THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA MAKES A SIGNIFICANT DONATION IN THE FIGHT AGAINST COVID-19

The People's Republic of China has made a significant donation of medical supplies to aid in the fight against the spread of COVID-19 in The Bahamas. On Tuesday April 28th, 2020 Chinese Ambassador His Excellency Mr. Huang Qinguo, signed the handover certificate on the China Aid Pandemic

Prevention Goods with Public Hospitals Authority (PHA) Deputy Director of the Supplies Management Agency (SMA) Mr. Audley G. Bain.

The donation, which was organized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in conjunction with the Ministry of Health, includes 500 disposable protective medical gowns, 500 protective face masks for medical use, 50 medical protective goggles, 500 sterile latex gloves, 500 medical isolation shoe covers, and 100 infrared thermometers.


