Minister of Housing and Transport **J o B e t h** Coleby-Davis told reporters yesterday that NO master plan was left in place by the former government. This means all work is now being started fresh and new by the team of Coleby-Davis, who will now have to revisit the land, create a true master plan to get direct costing of each planned affordable home for the 1,500+ applicants that applied for the prospect ridge project.

During the press release Mrs. Colbey-Davis highlighted that there is no possible way a photo rendering could have been completed for this project, when there was no work done on this project at

all. Which means the project billboard photos were fake and used as a political ploy by the former government. Coleby-Davis said the government might know in two to three weeks how to move forward with the project, but for now the studies on the land will take precedence given that the 83 acres of land, located north of John F. Kennedy Drive, between Prospect Ridge and the Ministry of Public Works, allegedly has many "sink holes" and other defects the Ministry of Public Works would have to contend with.

Wicardo Rolle's relatives discovered that he had been buried in an unmarked cemetery over a year after his murder.

Rolle's remains were not officially identified because he had no next-of-kin. And, due to mortuary capacity constraints, he was given a pauper's funeral with no mourners.

Dr. Michael Darville, Minister of Health, recently stated that the government would construct a new morgue with enhanced capacity.

On November 21, 2020, Rolle and his girlfriend Doreen Mortimer were murdered while sleeping inside an abandoned automobile on Ida Street.

His family members in Florida were not informed of his death, and their quest for their loved one ended in heartbreak.

Rolle's life was difficult after he was deported to The Bahamas after serving time in Florida for auto theft. He had no family in The Bahamas.

So he worked various jobs, but he still couldn't afford a house.

The sentence of a 57-year-old man who had inappropriate contact with a 13-year-old kid has been reduced by an Appeal Court.

Basil Cartwright was sentenced to three years in prison after pleading guilty to indecent assault in March.

He filed an appeal against the duration of his prison sentence, claiming that it was excessively harsh. The Court agreed and lowered his sentence to 12 months in prison. Cartwright could be

released from prison next month if he receives time off for good behavior.

The Court heard that Deputy Chief Magistrate Debbye Ferguson considered fining Cartwright \$8,000 for his offense at first.

However, she chose to first consult with the victim's parents. The adolescent's vocal father objected, claiming he expected "justice."

That's when Magistrate Ferguson changed his mind and handed Cartwright the maximum penalty.

Prosecutor Darnell Dorsette agreed with defence lawyer Paco Deal that the sentence was unsustainable because Cartwright did not receive time off for his guilty plea.

They disagreed, however, on the proper penalty.

Dorsette, for her part, proposed a sentence of one to one and a half

years. Deal, on the other hand, requested an eight-month sentence.

Dorsette proposed a one-year or 18-month sentence.

Deal, on the other side, stated that an eight-month sentence was appropriate.

The three-judge panel found that a 12-month sentence matched

the offence after considering Cartwright's early guilty plea, good character, and contrition.







FNM financiers the Holoweskos and Johnson's best friend Dr. John Rodgers are at the top of the list of potential bidders. Johnson reportedly died broke, as the paper's circulation had plunged in recent years as Internet pages provided

readers a regular diet of gossip with free photographs and videos.

IRAM LEWIS WITH OUT A FIGHTING CHANCE IS TRYING HIS HAND AT LEADERSHIP OF THE FNM PARTY

Former Youth Sports and Culture Minister Iram Lewis, one of seven Free National Movement candidates to win a seat in the September 16 General Election, has stated his intention to run for party leader at

the November 27 convention, potentially against Dr. Hubert Minnis.

Minnis has openly avoided the idea of another leadership race, but is thought to be making behind-the-scenes calls to rally support from 500 council members.

Lewis, on the other hand, believes it is time for a change in the FNM. On Wednesday, the Member of Parliament for Central Grand Bahama formally announced his intention to run for the position.

Lewis, one of seven Free National Movement members elected to the House of Assembly, believes he is the ideal candidate for leader because of his servant leadership style, readiness to listen, and inclusion of dissenting ideas.

FNM MP Michael Pintard and former Minister of Health Dr. Duane Sands are both said to be interested in the position of party leader.

A judge determined Tuesday that a case brought by a lawyer who was arrested after a heated exchange with a magistrate will be heard.

The Attorney General's Office, which was also a defendant in the case, had requested that Romona Farquharson's case against Magistrate Carolyn Vogt-Evans be dismissed.

After finding Farquharson guilty of contempt, the magistrate ordered her arrest and detention on March 8, 2017.

Farquharson appeared in court on behalf of Melinda Clayton.

During the trial, a disagreement arose regarding the admission of evidence.

According to the lawsuit, the magistrate ordered Farquharson to "shut up and sit down."

The magistrate then found Farquharson in contempt of court and ordered her detention and transport to the jail block.

According to reports, the Judge asked the arresting officer to "escort her through the prisoner's dock. She is the same as everyone else."

Farquharson claims the magistrate lacks the authority to hold her in

contempt.

Furthermore, she was never told why she was held in contempt, nor was she given the opportunity to defend herself.

Farquharson stated that she was paraded through male detainees in the prisoner's dock before being transported to the cell block, where she remained for three hours.

Farquharson is suing for reputational harm, violations of constitutional rights, and unlawful arrest and false imprisonment.

However, Crown lawyers David Whymms and Sophia Thompson-Williams asked the court to dismiss the case.

They contended that the AG's Office could not be held liable for the magistrate's alleged activities. Farquharson is represented by Gia Moxey.

BPC SEEKING PARTNER TO DRILL

According to Press Secretary Clint Watson, Prime Minister Philip Davis is “consulting with experts” to establish his administration’s future position on oil drilling.

During the first Office of the Prime Minister news briefing, Watson informed the Prime Minister that he has consulted specialists to examine whether his opinion on the topic will alter or remain the same.

While opposing oil drilling, Davis stated his support for it as long as it is done in a “environmentally benign” manner.

He earlier informed

reporters that he still supports the arrangement reached with the Bahamas Petroleum Company (BPC), now Challenger Energy, to exploit the natural resource for the benefit of the Bahamian people if commercial quantities are discovered.

He also previously admitted that his legal firm briefly represented BPC, but claimed he broke relations owing to what he regarded to be a conflict of interest well before the 2007 general election.

The company is now concentrating on extending the licenses for a third three-year exploration period

and seeking a partner — ideally a significant industry player — to offer knowledge and finance for the next phase of activities.

The Perseverance #1 well was the first exploratory drilling in The Bahamas since the mid-1980s, as well as the first test of any prospect located in deeper waters off the shallower water carbonate banks.

Drilling was completed without incident and without the finding of commercial quantities of oil in February of this year.

“What the Prime Minister has been doing is engaging the Ministry of the Environment, the experts, to talk about where we are, what is required of us

internationally, and if we do that, this will be the result,” Watson said.

“Right now, he is talking to specialists to acquire the greatest analysis and recommendations, and based on that, he will draft a policy that will go before Cabinet and Parliament.”

He is currently speaking with professionals in the sector to determine what is best for The Bahamas, how we will accomplish this in a safe manner, and how it will benefit the Bahamian people.


