

The FNM branch of


Seabreeze already met with its "candidate" and things were moving along well, but this PLP navel string, niece of Pindling would not be gone in the wind.



What BN suspects is that even though authorities all over are saying


taking the vaccine is not mandatory, it will be necessary for eventual passage into a whole lot of places like restaurants, airlines and some offices. That's our suspicion.

BUSINESS *UNCUT!* BAHAMAS AIR BOOKINGS IS LOOKING BETTER!

Bahamasair Managing Director Tracy Cooper said yesterday that the airline is “reasonably pleased” with the increase in domestic and international passenger traffic, but that “we’re not out of the woods.”

“There is no doubt that we have seen better movement of persons in and around the Bahamas, as well as to and from the Bahamas,” Cooper said.

“We’ve been pleased with what we’ve seen so far.

March, around Easter time, was one of the better months since the pandemic began.

“By any stretch of the imagination, we are not out of the woods yet, but we have seen some good traffic.”

“At this time, the recovery we know is probably not going to be

100 percent; everyone is predicting 50 to 60 percent of what might have been the best outcome,” Cooper said of the airline’s recovery.

“We anticipate being in that area as well.

We won’t be at full strength, but the idea is that as things progress, we’ll reap the benefits.”

The airline is expected to lose \$50 to \$60 million in the year

ending June 2021 as a result of the pandemic.

Bahamasair plans to add more flights to Abaco from West Palm Beach, Florida later this month.

“Whenever we add flights to a specific location, we try to engage the stakeholders to help us along the way,” Cooper explained.

“We did that by engaging with Abaco stakeholders, who pointed us in the direction of what they thought would improve the island’s tourism product.

“We took a look at the information they provided, analyzed it,

and made the necessary changes.

We increased the number of flights into West Palm Beach from two to four per week.”

VACCINATION BY FORCE IS A NO NO!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

In a purported letter to staff, titled 'Mandatory Vaccination Policy', Mayu Holdings Limited, the company, operating as Sushi Rokkan, said all employees are required to get vaccinated no later than June 30, 2021.

Management noted that failure to comply with the mandatory vaccination policy may lead to "disciplinary action being taken, which could result in dismissal or at the very least re-assignment to another position — if such can be found — minimizing direct and proximate contact with the public".

"Sushi Rokkan has a duty to provide and maintain a safe workplace," read the letter.

"We are adopting this policy to safeguard the health of our employees and their families, our customers and visitors and the community at large from COVID-19, which is reduced by vaccinations. In making this decision, management has reviewed recommendations by the World Health Organization and the government of The Bahamas.

"As government's roll-out of vaccine administration has not proceeded with the speed

and efficiency we had anticipated, we are giving you ample opportunity in the form of two months' notice, before rigid implementation of this policy.

"If you are unwilling to be vaccinated on medical ground, you will be required to support this objection by a medical certificate from a qualified epidemiologist, virologist or immunologist or other equivalent medical specialist.

Director of Labour John Pinder said yesterday that his department received numerous complaints and inquiries from associates of Sushi Rokkan after the restaurant in

Old Fort Bay Town Center reportedly advised associates of a new mandatory COVID-19 vaccination policy effective immediately.

"Nobody is mandated to take that," Says Pinder

"You voluntarily decide whether you are going to take that or not. No employer has the right to force any employee to take any vaccination. That's not law and the competent authority did not make that a part of the emergency orders, so no employer has the right to force any employee to do that."

He continued: "I have been receiving calls from employees from more than that establishment;

not just that establishment; about two other establishments, where they are saying the employers are trying to make it mandatory for them to take [the vaccine] or they can't return to work. Now, the employer has a right to hold you in furlough until 30 days after the expiration of the emergency orders. Now, after that they got to bring you back to work. I have heard some employers will force you to pay for your own COVID test. I have no problem with that, but they cannot make it mandatory for you to take the vaccination."



METEOR PASSES NEAR GRAND BAHAMA

On Monday night shortly after 10pm home security and surveillance systems recorded the entrance of a meteor fireball. This amazing sighting was able to be seen by people from Northern Bahamas to Jacksonville Florida.

It is believed that the space stone was the size of a small car. Many

residents in Grand Bahama reported hearing a loud boom and tremor in their homes.

Interesting enough meteors historically have entered the earth realm and have either exploded in the air, landed in open spaces in remote places or in the oceans. Upon land impact searchers will seek out the space rocks for their value.

It is believed that meteors fall daily however

the day's light absorbed its visibility. Monday's sighting exploded in air and is the second recorded sighting for the year the first one being in January.


